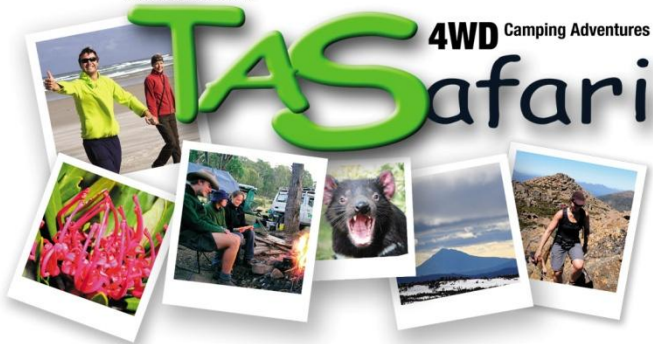

realise Wild Tasmania!

Edge of the Earth TASafari

This tour starts in **Hobart** and finishes in **Hobart**. **4 Days and 3 Nights** Camping and Walking Tour

WOW – look south into an ocean wilderness – next stop Antarctica – this is the edge of the earth, the edge of Tasmania, the edge of the great south land. Stunning walks to highpoints with **World Heritage** views and out to the edges for wild sea spray. **Wildlife in the wild** – sea life, native mammals, rare birds. Evening laughs around a campfire, dinner and snuggle into a swag For four days we head south from Hobart and visit some of Tassie's most well kept secrets, Cockle Creek, Hartz Mountains, Hastings Caves and Bruny Island just to name a few. Great campsites, beaches, mountains, caves, forests and fishing villages all make our trip to the edge of the Earth or at least the southern edge of Tassie a ripper.

Each day we participate in bush walks from 1- 5 hours and travel by four-wheel-drive troop carriers, Landrovers or small mini buses which are ideal for small personal groups. Each night we experience bush camping and delicious meals with campfire cooking. When we camp we use tents and sleeping mats. We see and appreciate Tasmania's unique wildlife in the wild.

Day 1 (L,D) Hartz Mountains

Pick up from accom in Hobart at 7:am and go south!!

Bushwalk in **Hartz Mountains** NP for spectacular views into South **West World Heritage** wilderness.

Alpine picnic and then further south. Enjoy a dip in Hastings thermal springs and option of a **cave tour**.

Set up camp way down south at idyllic **Recherche Bay**

Day 2 (B,L,D) South Cape Bay

Go as far south as the land will take us with a day walk to **South Cape Bay**.

Return to our camp and an afternoon swim and try some fishing for dinner!

Day 9 (B,L,D) Huon Valley and Bruny Island

Drive through scenic **Huon Valley** to meet the ferry to Bruny Island.

Bush walk to the highest point of the island, picnic lunch with a view!

Afternoon coastal walk around from our camp site on the southern side of the island.

Day 10 (B,L) Labillardiere Peninsular

Bushwalk on the remote **Labillardiere Peninsular**. Awesome coastal views. Wildlife – sea mammals and birds.

Lunch and a swim. What a great day!

Return to Hobart late in the afternoon. Drop off to accom.

NOTE Sometimes this tours is undertaken in reverse and visits Bruny Island first

Tasafari is part of the Green Guradians Program with the Tasmanian Parks and Wildlife Service



Our tours are exploratory in nature with a combination of walking, exploring and touring. TASafari place a significant emphasis on running a business and tours that are low impact and sustainable

All inclusive small group guided 4 Day active camping and walking tour exploring the south coast and Bruny Island of Tasmania. All food from Lunch Day 1 to Lunch to Day 4, transport, parks passes; camping and cooking equipment is provided.

Highlights include World Heritage Areas, Hastings Caves, Hartz Mountains, Southern Ocean, South Coast, Bruny Island, Wildlife and remote beaches.

Starts 7am Hobart concludes Approx 5pm Launceston. Departs Thursdays and Sundays Min 4 Max 12 people



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
